Re: Temporary Delay to TAT for CDT (Carbohydrate Deficient Transferrin) Testing


Dear Colleague,

We have been notified by our referral laboratory that there will be a temporary change in turn-around time with CDT samples the week beginning 21st September. This is due to an instalment of a new analyser. There will be no change in reference range, however the TAT will increase to a minimum of 5-6 working days.

Once the new analysers have been installed the turn-around time will return to normal.
